The School of Architecture, Planning, and Landscape Architecture (APLA) at Auburn University - a comprehensive land-grant research institution located in Auburn, Alabama, is accepting applications for two tenure-track (9 month/year,) positions. This positions will begin August 16, 2016. Salary will be competitive and academic rank will be commensurate with experience and qualifications.

APLA has a 105-year history of educating architects, interior architects, landscape architects and planners, and of contributing to our regional communities and design professions through outreach, scholarship, and creative work. The School has three allied degree programs: Bachelor of Architecture, Bachelor of Interior Architecture, and Master of Landscape Architecture. APLA resides in the College of Architecture, Design and Construction along with the McWhorter School of Building Science and department of Industrial and Graphic Design.

APLA's Architecture Program offers a fully accredited 5-year Bachelor of Architecture degree that is among the most highly ranked in the country. The program features a diverse and collegial faculty body that works collectively to integrate the pedagogical aims of design studio with those of the building technology, architectural history, and design theory courses. Our ideal candidate will be interested in both the development and implementation of new forms, methods and venues for that continued collaboration.

The teaching responsibilities of this position will include architectural design studios, lecture courses in architectural history, and seminars in contemporary architectural history and theory. The successful candidate will also be required to maintain an active scholarly program disseminated through appropriate disciplinary, peer-reviewed venues.

Requirements for this position include a master's degree in architecture, or a professional degree in architecture and a terminal degree in a related field. Desired qualifications include: experience teaching in a professional architecture degree program, the interest and ability to develop and teach courses which emphasize the integration of architectural design and history, architectural registration, professional practice experience, additional degrees in history or related fields, the ability to develop a productive research/creative work scholarly program.
