TEACHING

Consistent with the ideal of a university education, I am interested in the process of learning, and in helping each student to find his way, to thrive in the discovery of knowledge and opportunity, and to recognize her responsibility both as an individual and as a citizen contributing to our collective culture and society.

The whole is greater than the sum of the parts, an opportunity for community.

It is exciting to encourage education as the process of forming and expressing ideas, rather than the dispensing and receiving of information.

I have focused my teaching efforts on the individual student in the context of the class, and have worked at being available as a teacher and mentor, to foster the love of learning, the investigation of an idea, and the discovery of the ability to think creatively in the effort to understand and solve complex problems in the larger context of the community and society.

In my creative work, research, outreach, and service I always strive to weave all of these opportunities together, to share insight and expertise, and to contribute to the collective effort to shape our environment, both the physical and intellectual. The overarching concern is to offer and add to the whole of the community, building community.

Learning is a life-long pursuit, sharing knowledge and insight one of the most rewarding benefits. The University is an extraordinary resource as a community of scholars.

But above all, it is expected that the attention of the instructors to the disposition of the minds and the morals of the youth under their charge will exceed every other care; well considering that though goodness without knowledge is weak and feeble, yet knowledge without goodness is dangerous, and that both united form the noblest of character, and lay the surest foundation of usefulness to mankind.
